# Introduction

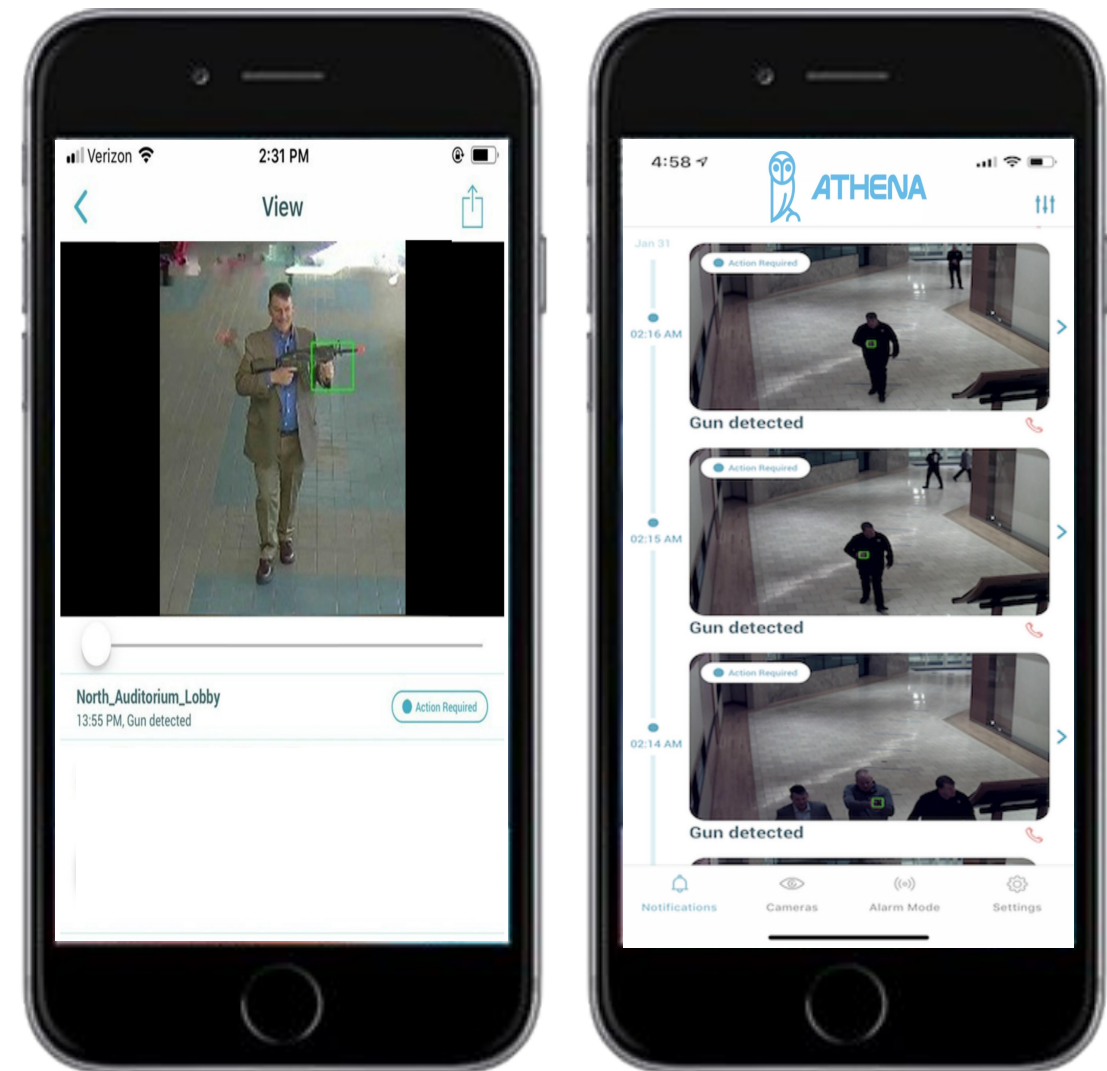
The Athena Gun Detection System is a new security technology that alerts security operators and other responders when a gun or threat is seen by your surveillance cameras.

The Athena Gun Detection System App is the primary method for delivering threat alerts. Threat alerts provide up to the second information on the who, what, where and when of threats in progress.

If you have been provided with access to this app, it is possible that you will be asked to use the information provided by this system to inform critical and urgent response actions with life saving implications.

All actions taken by operators using this application should be completed in accordance with your organization’s event response procedures and under the immediate direction of the established command structure.

This user guide will familiarize you with the features and functions of this app.



# Installing the Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App On Your iPhone

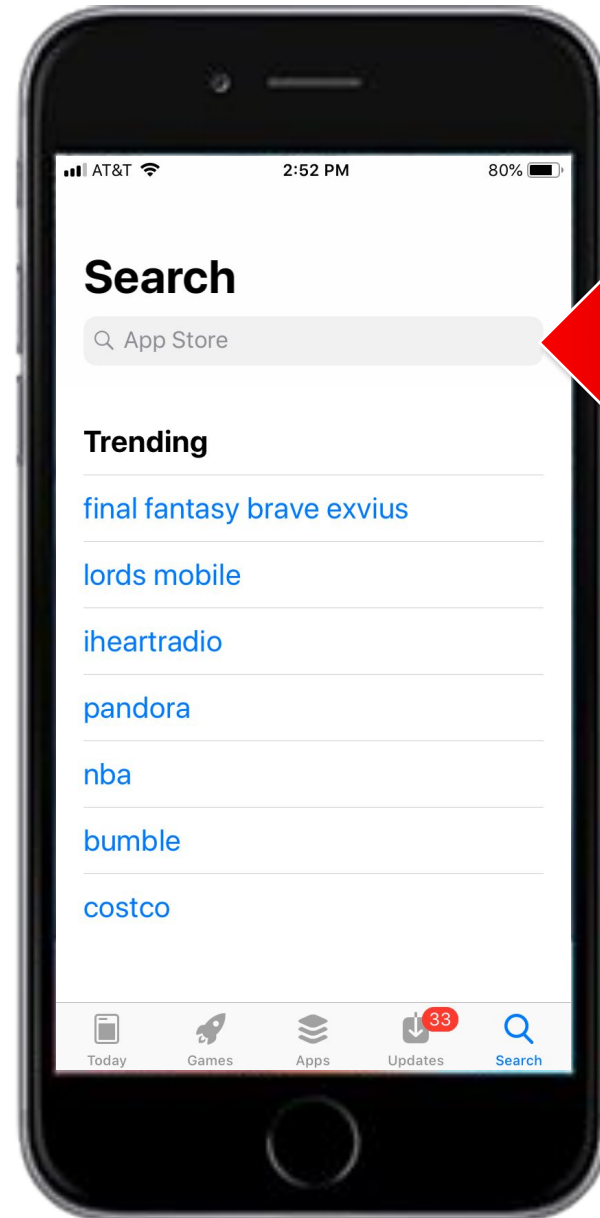
## Downloading The Application

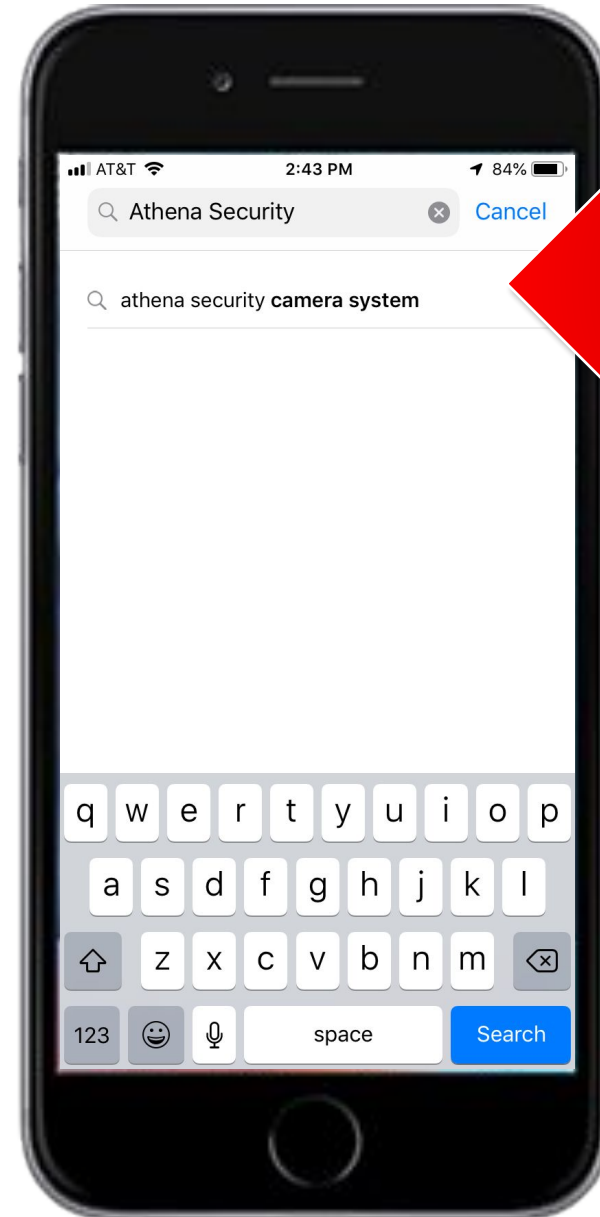
1. - Go to the Search bar

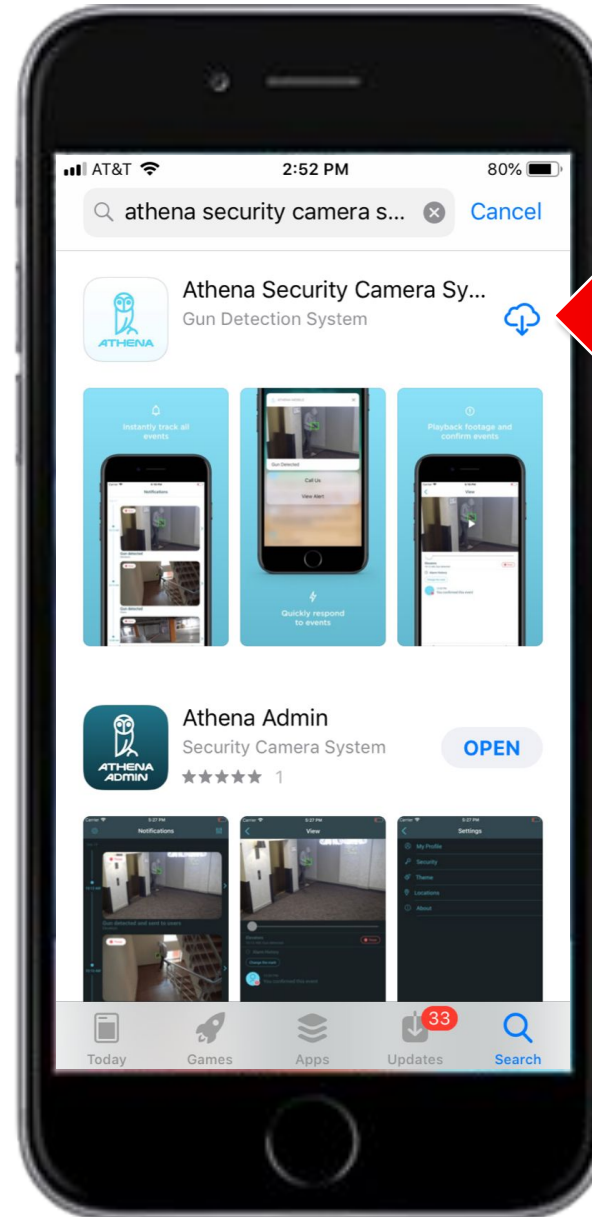
# Installing the Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App On Your iPhone

# Installing the Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App On Your iPhone

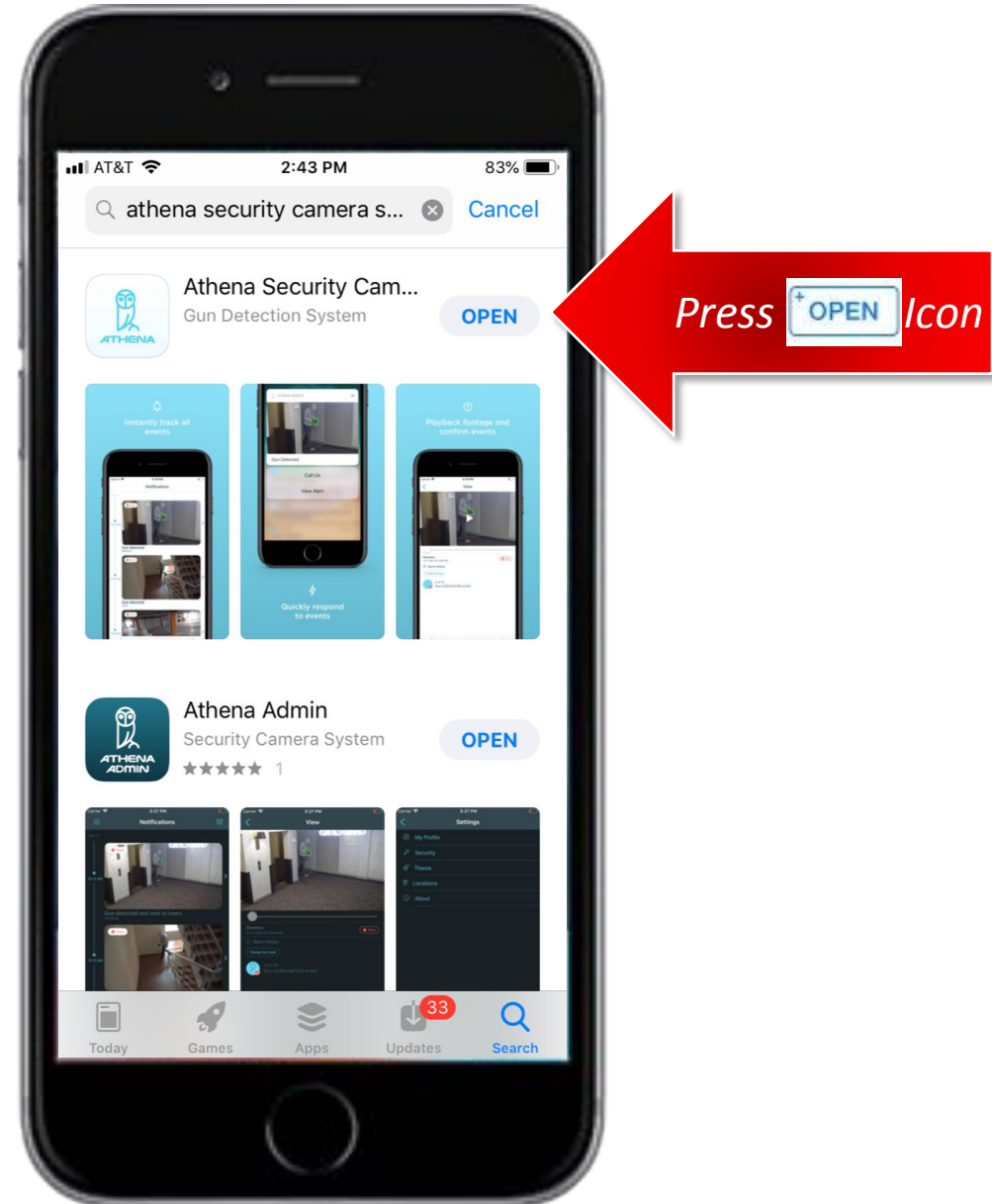
1. - Two Athena Apps will display. A light blue user app and a dark background admin app
2. - Select the user app with a light blue background.
3. - Download the app to your iPhone by pressing the  icon.

# Installing the Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App On Your iPhone

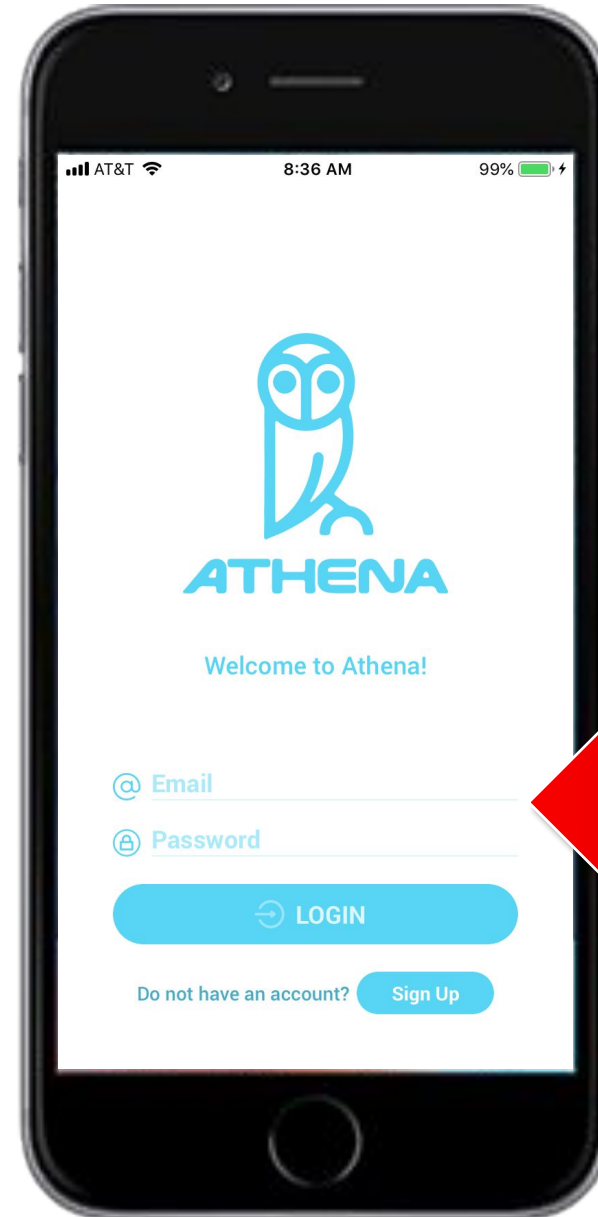
1. - When the app download is complete, the  icon will appear.
2. - Download time for the application depends on network performance.
3. - Press the  icon to open the application
4. - App installation is now complete.





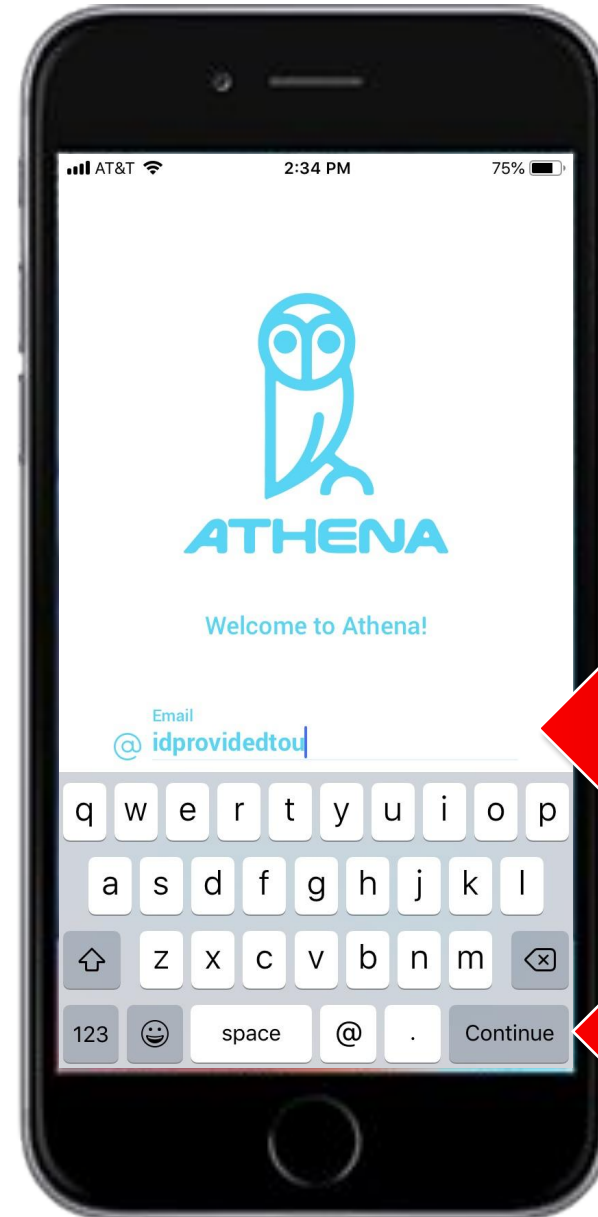
# Logging In - Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App

- 1- Upon opening the app, you will be required to log in.
- 2.- You will use the ID and password that has been provided by your organization. ID is typically your work email.

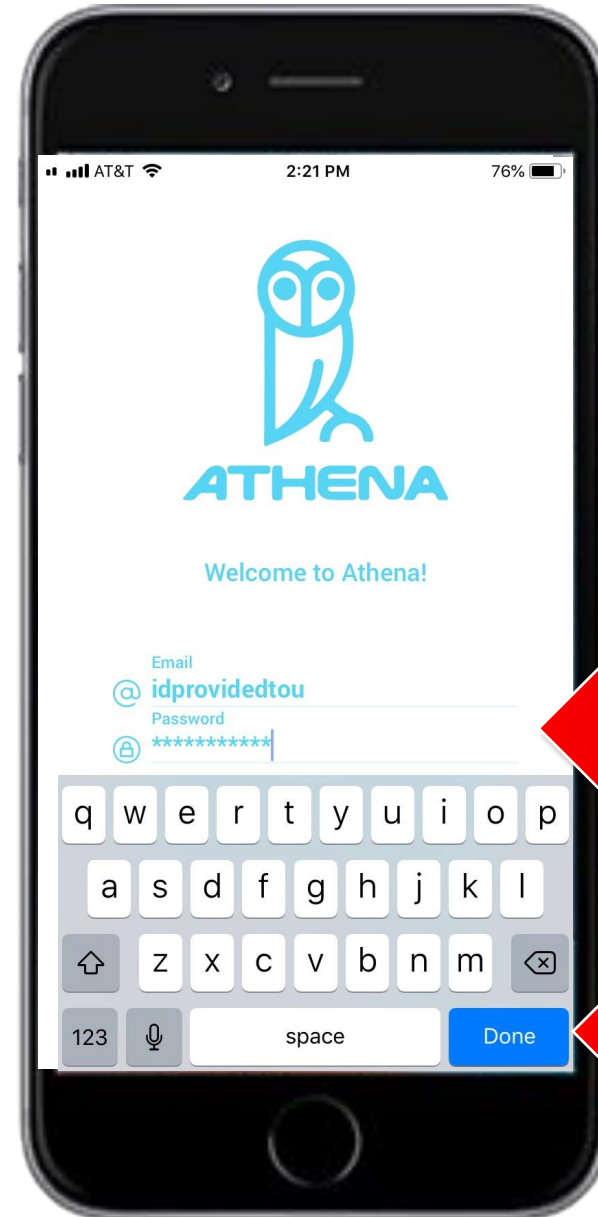
# Logging In - Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App

# Setting Up Your Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App



1. - The first time that you log in to the app, it will prompt to allow notifications.
2. - The primary function of this app is to provide timely alerts when threats, like guns, are detected. These alerts are sent via “Notifications”
3. - Press the “Allow” menu choice to enable the app to send alerts to your iPhone

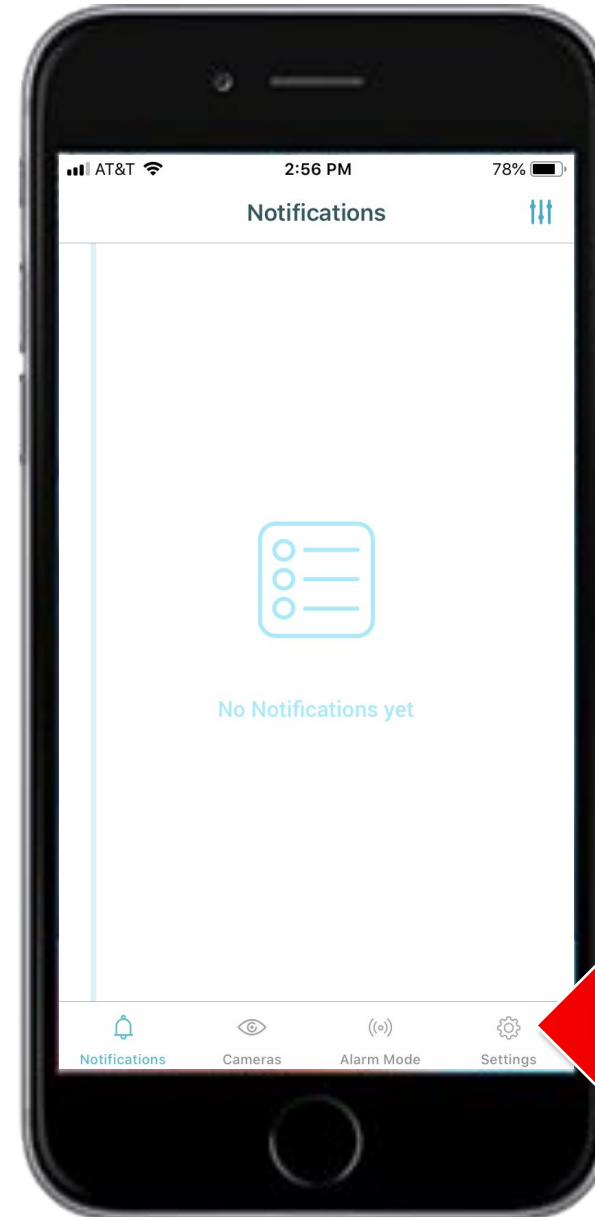


## *Concerned About Receiving Notifications When Not At Work?*


- 1 – Log out of the application at the end of shift
- 2 – You will not receive notifications when logged out.
- 3 – Remember to log in when you want to receive notifications

# Changing Your Password - Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App



1. - Changing your password is an easy process.
2. - From the Notifications screen, locate the  "Settings" icon at the bottom of the screen.
- 3.- Press the  "Settings" icon.

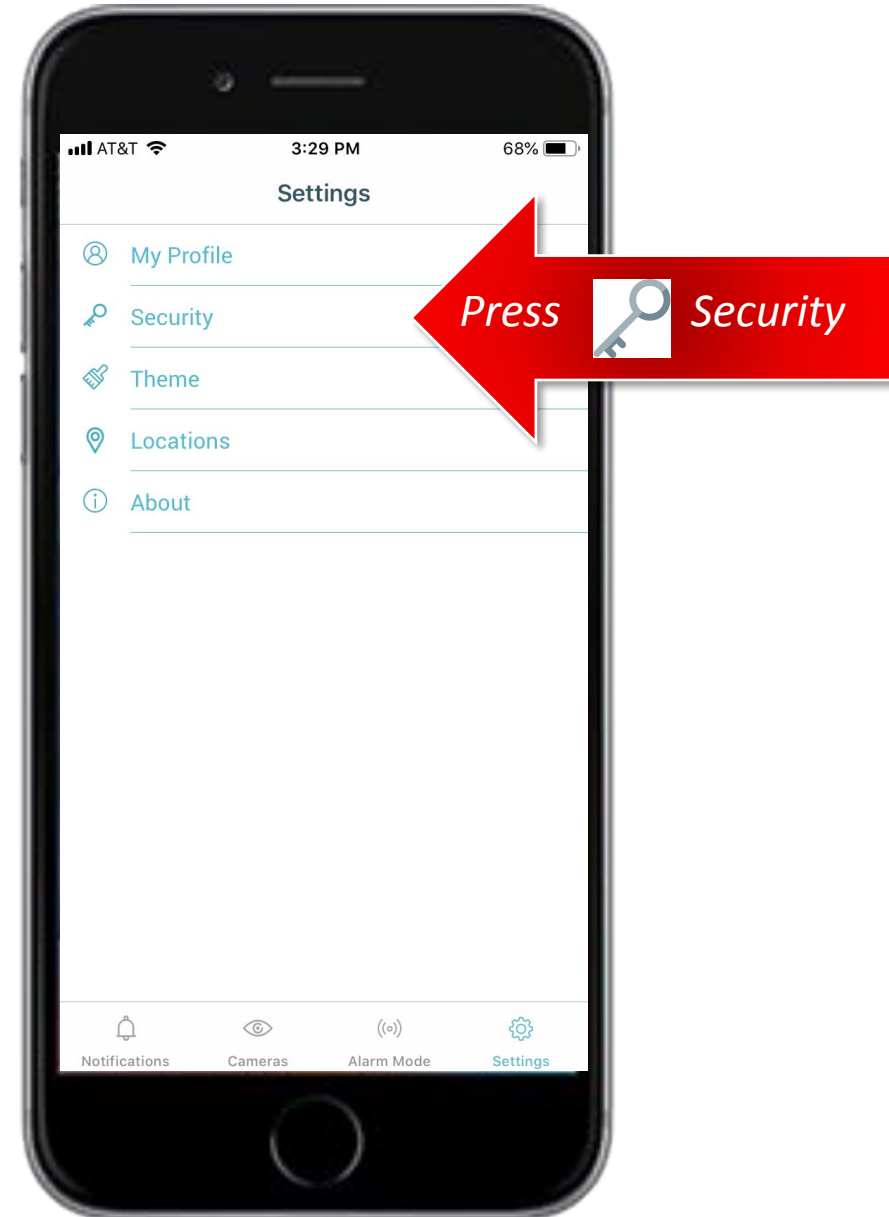


Press  Settings



 Periodically changing your password, especially on the first log-in, is considered a good security practice.

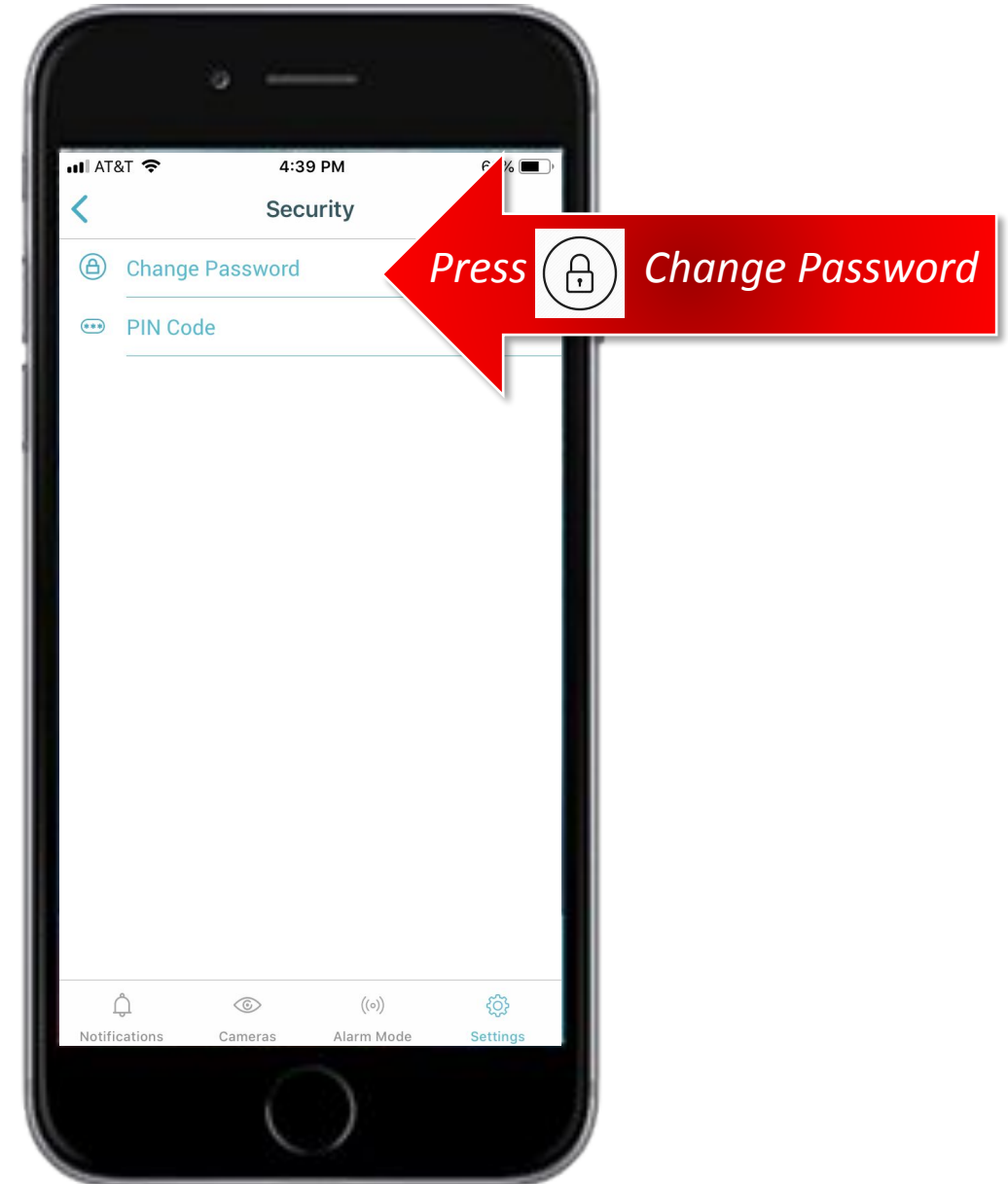

- 2.- Press the  “Security ” button.



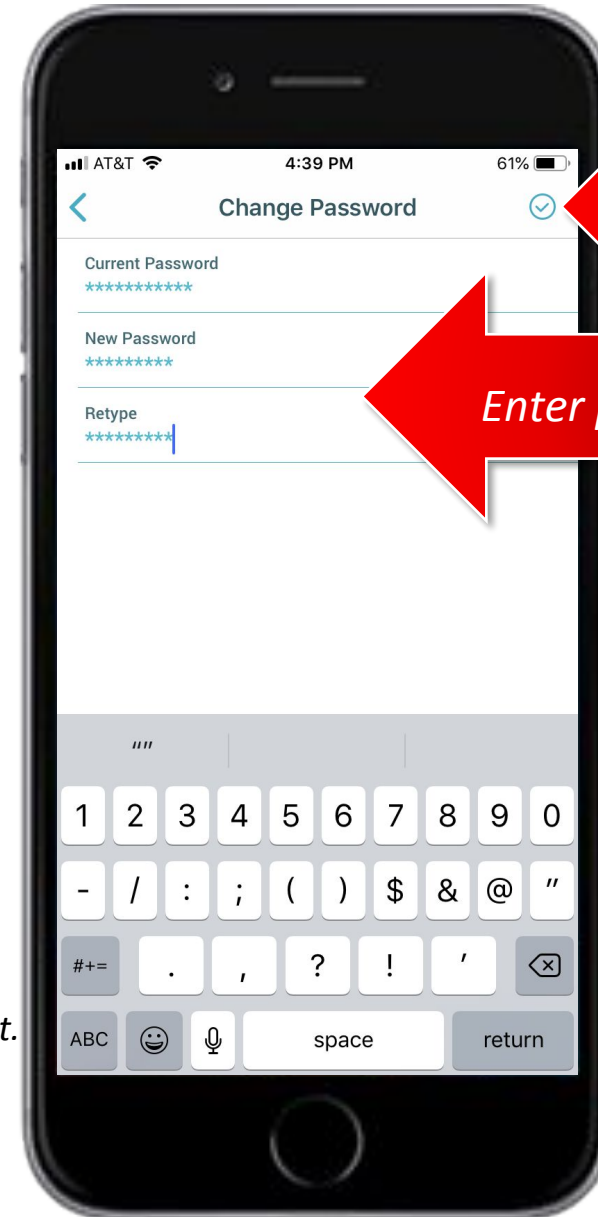
# Changing Your Password - Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App

# Changing Your Password - Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App

- 1- Type current password
- 2.-Type new password
- 3.- Re-type new password
- 4.- Press the ☑ icon in the upper right corner to save changes.

Enter password information here

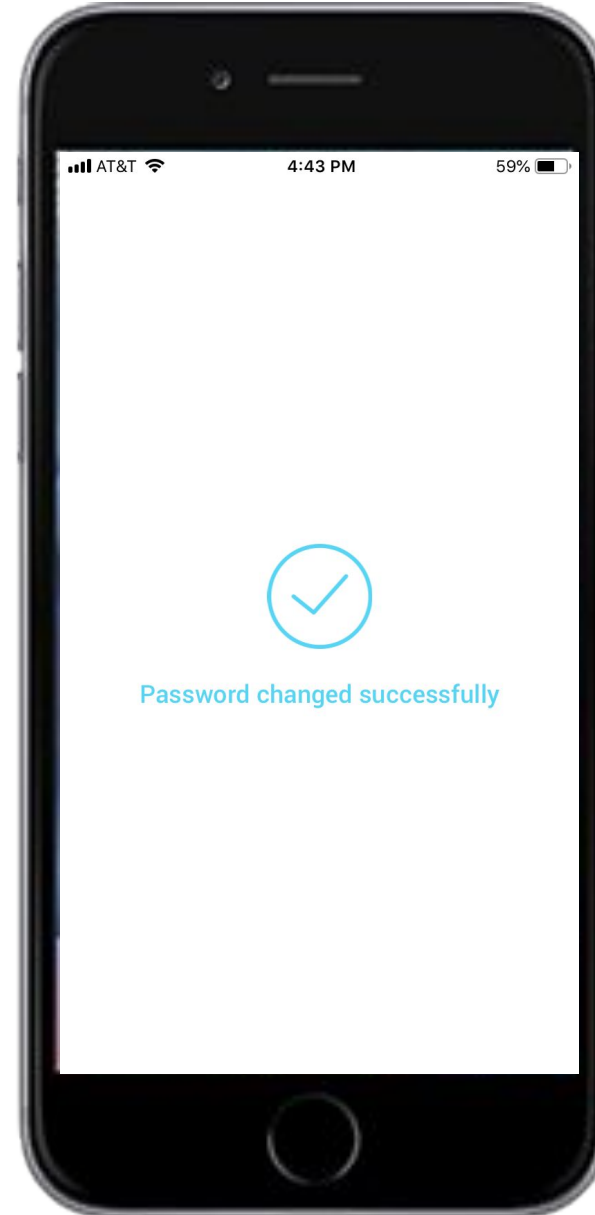


App will prompt you to re-enter information if Current Password entered is incorrect.  
App will prompt you to re-enter information if New Passwords do not match.





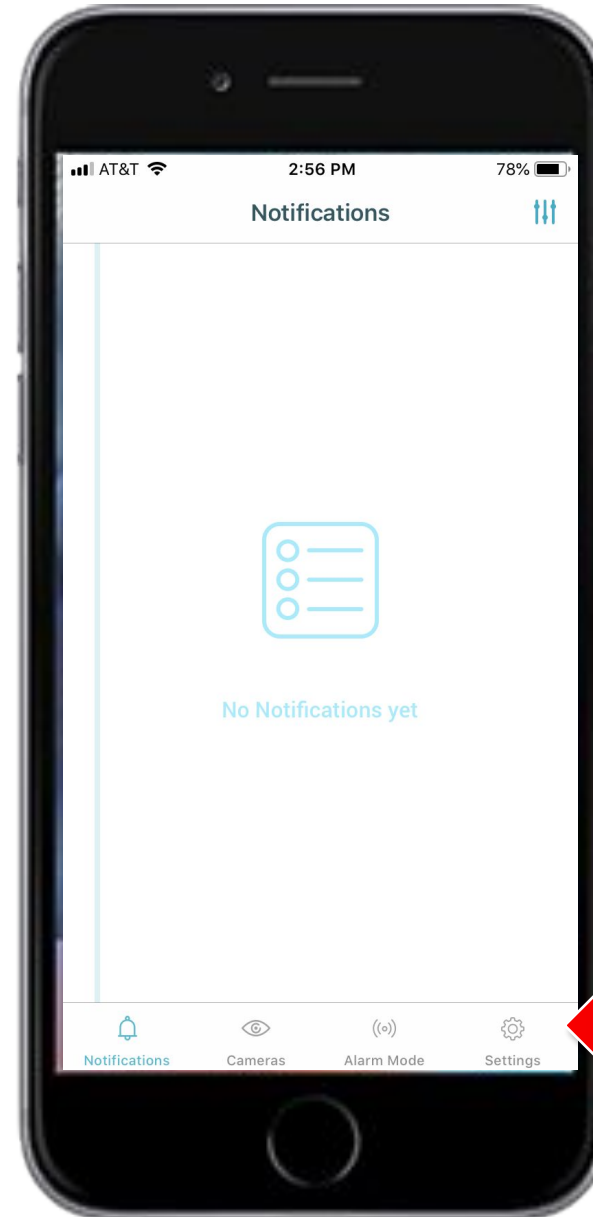

- 2.- Press the  "Settings" icon.



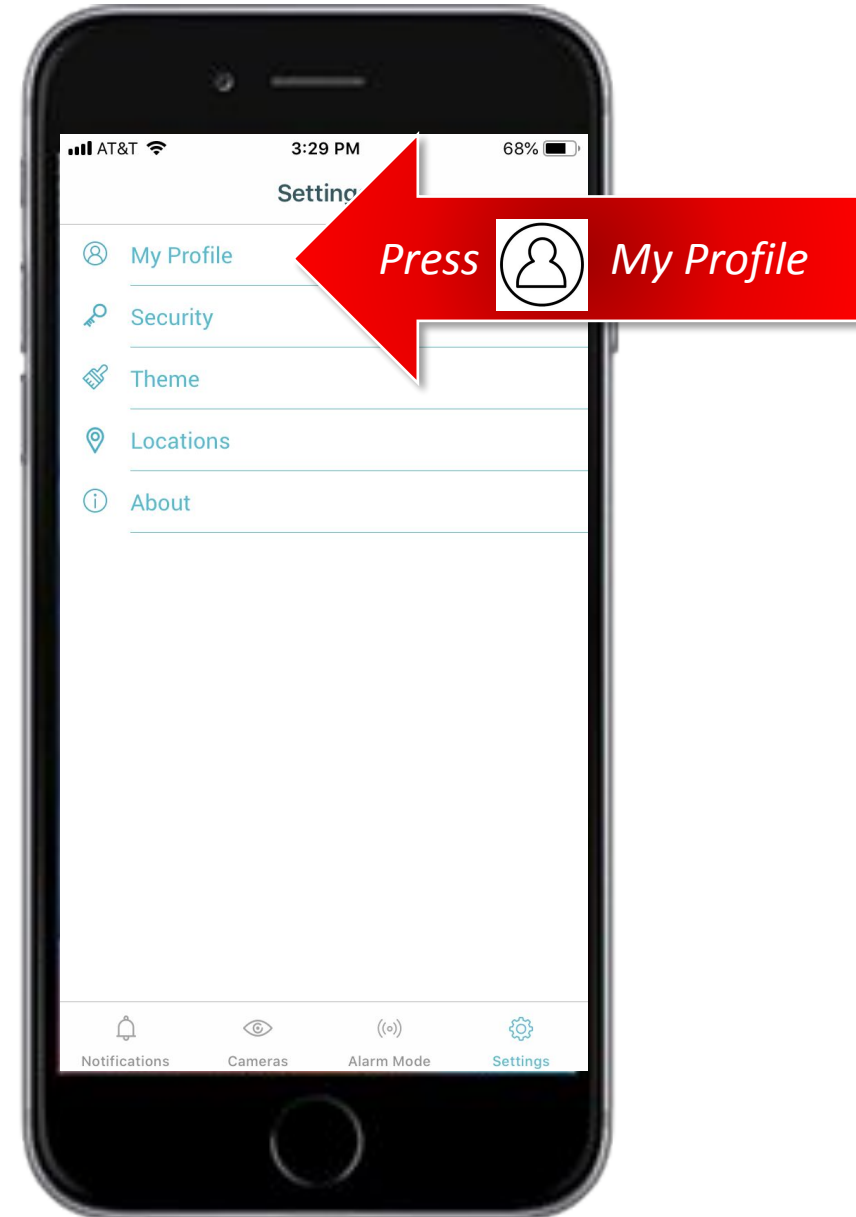

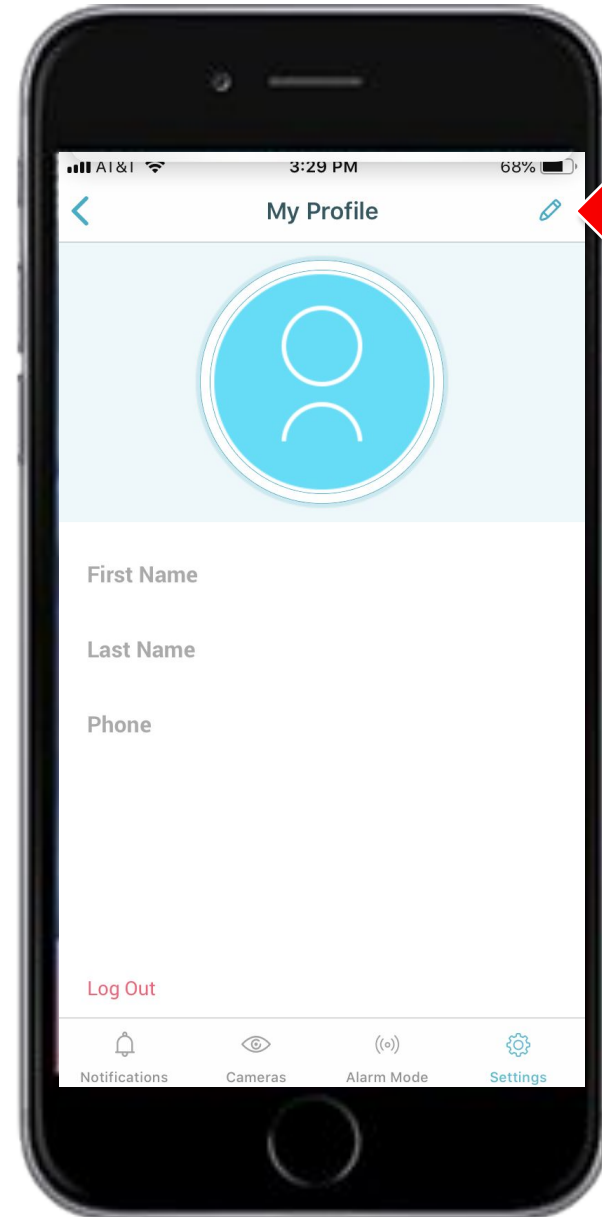

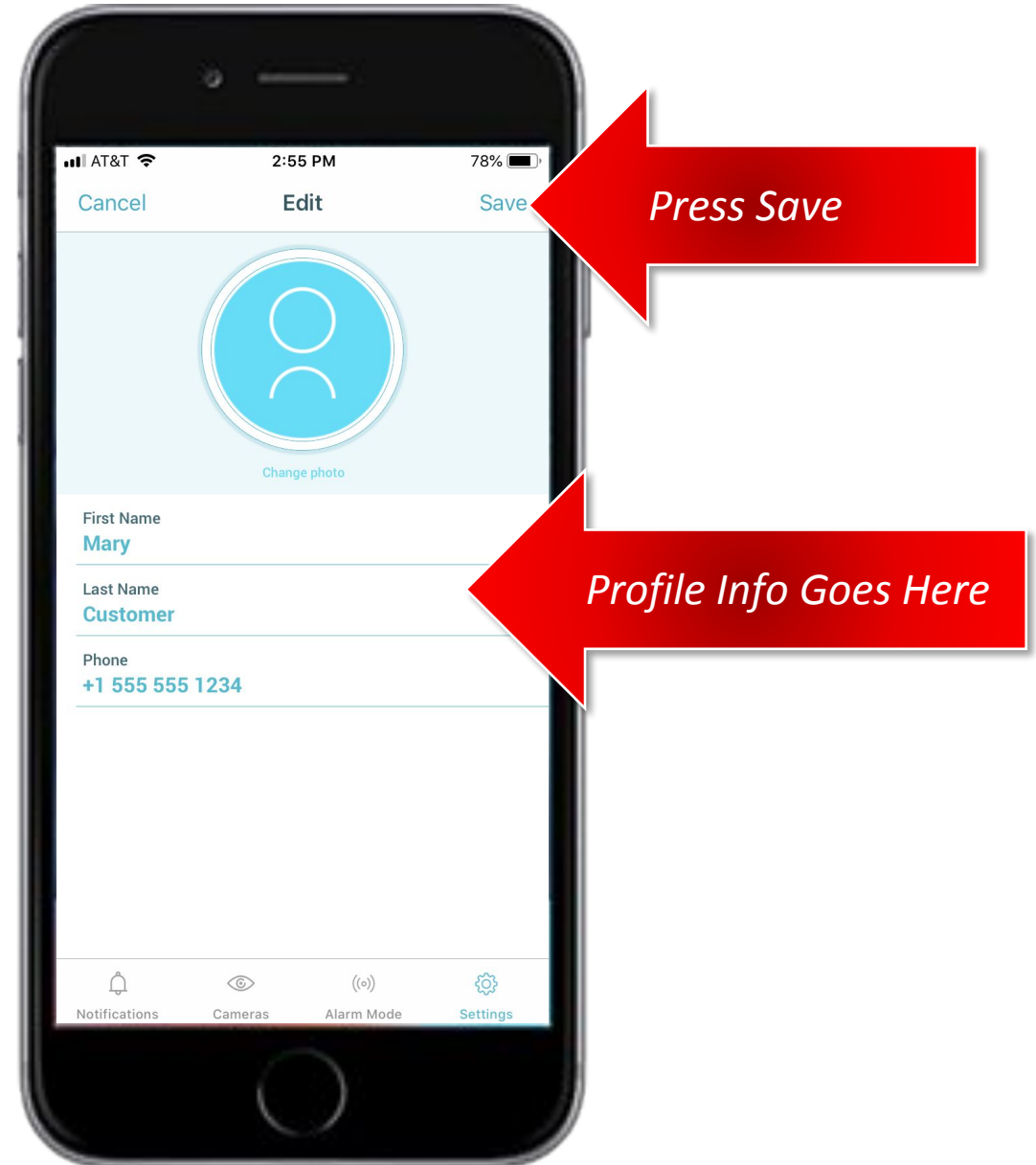
- 1- From the My Profile screen, locate the  icon in the upper right corner.

# Setting Up Your Profile - Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App

- 1- Type First Name and Last Name on lines provided
- 2.- Type phone number beginning with country code "1" for the United States
- 3.- Locate the "Save" button in the upper right corner.
- 4.- Review information entered and press the "Save" button.

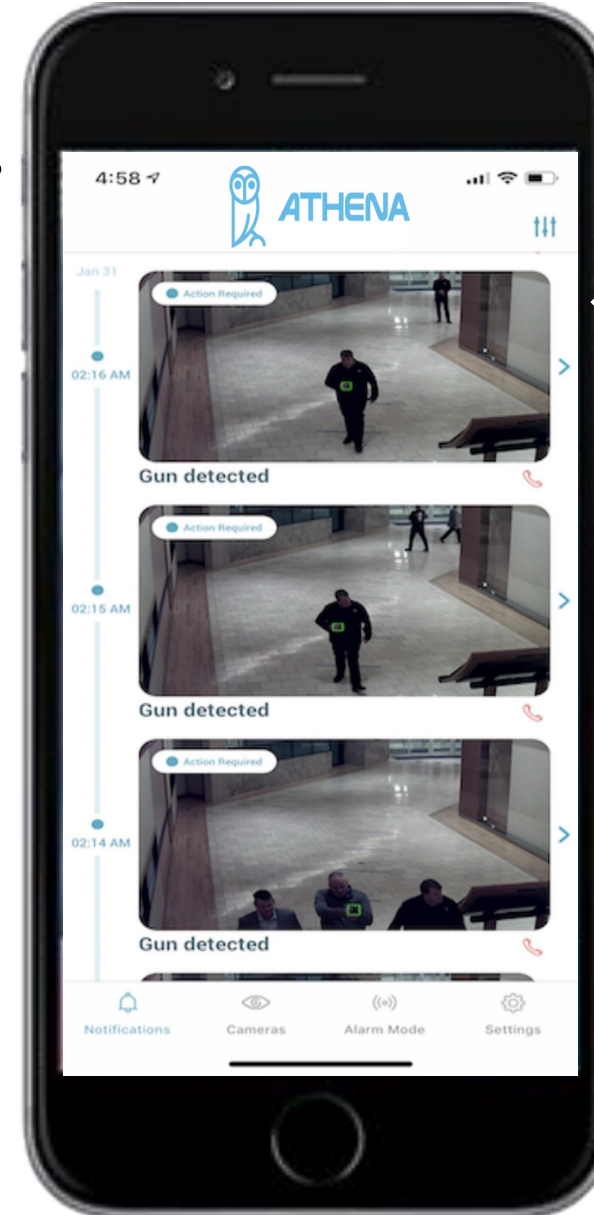


The app does not require a photo to be placed in your profile. If you wish to add a photo to your profile, press the Change photo button below the picture icon. You will be given the option to take a photo with your iPhone or select an existing photo from your camera roll.

# Threat Detection Alerts - Athena Security Camera System

## Gun Detection System App

1. - Once a gun is detected, the Athena system continues to track the threat as it is seen by your surveillance cameras
2. – An ongoing history or timeline of the threat appears in the Notifications screen when the app is opened.
3. – You can navigate up or down in the timeline by swiping the screen consistent with other iOS applications.
4. - Press the > to expand a timeline entry



*Alert Timeline History*



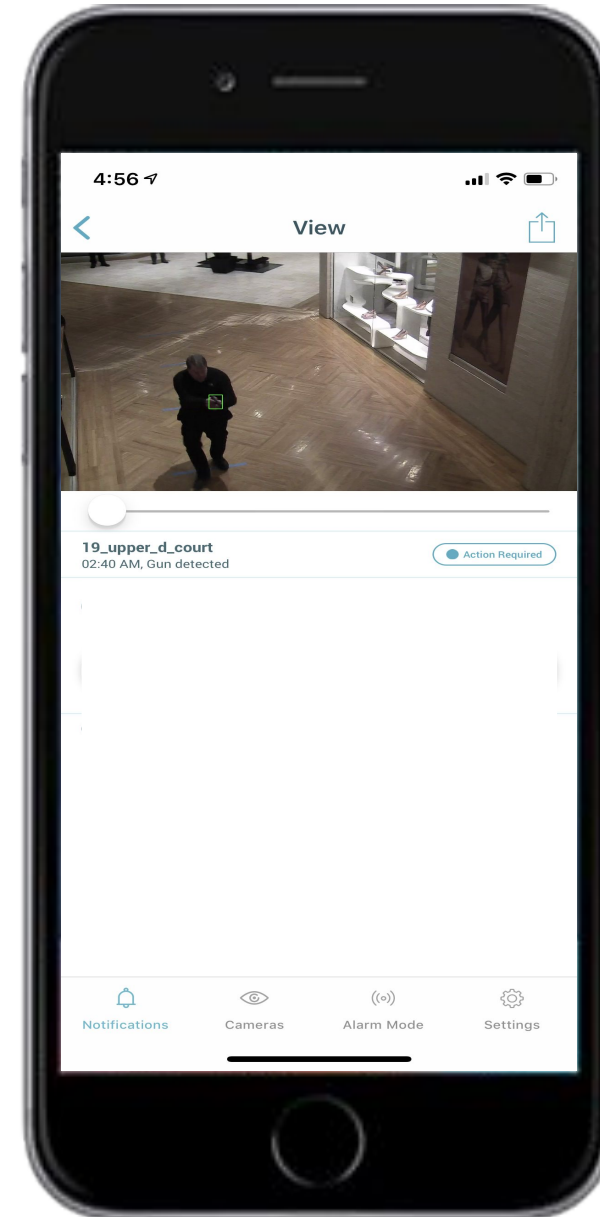
*Swipe Up or Down to navigate timeline history*



# Threat Detection Alerts - Athena Security Camera System



## Gun Detection System App

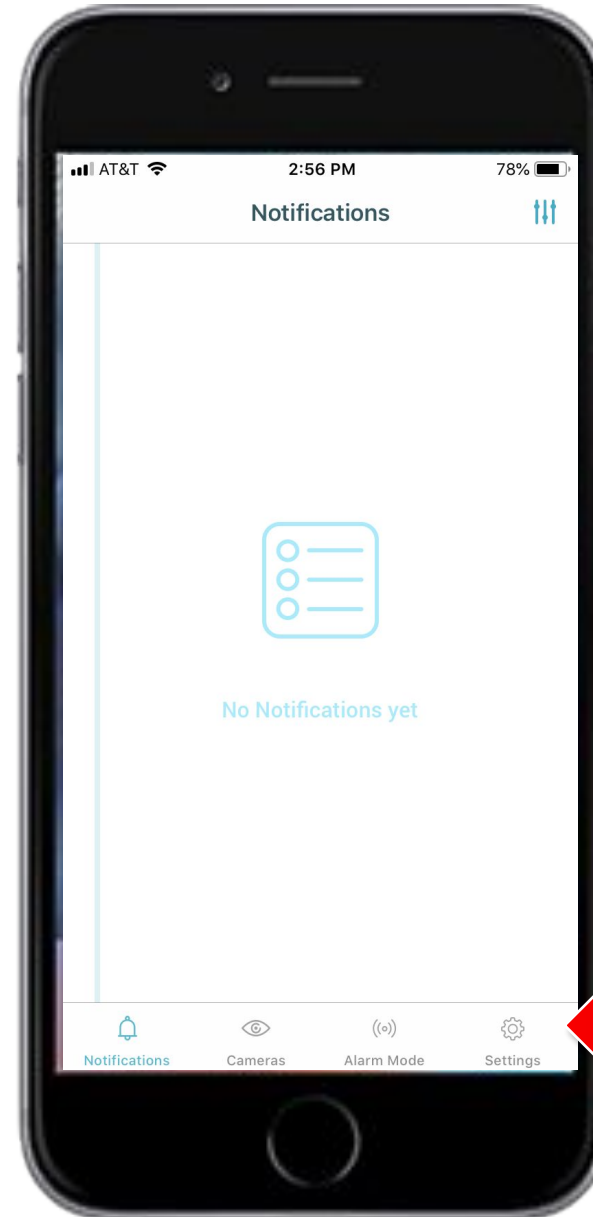
1. – Pressing the > icon on the timeline page displays an expanded view of information for a specific detection.
2. – This expanded view includes a larger image and a video clip of the detected individual including a bounding box highlighting the gun that was detected.
3. – Use the slider button just below the image to fast forward or rewind the video.
- 4.- The expanded view includes both the detection time and camera location.
5. – Press the < icon to return to the timeline page.



*Event response and actions taken should be in coordination with your organization's response protocols and procedures and based on established command structures.*

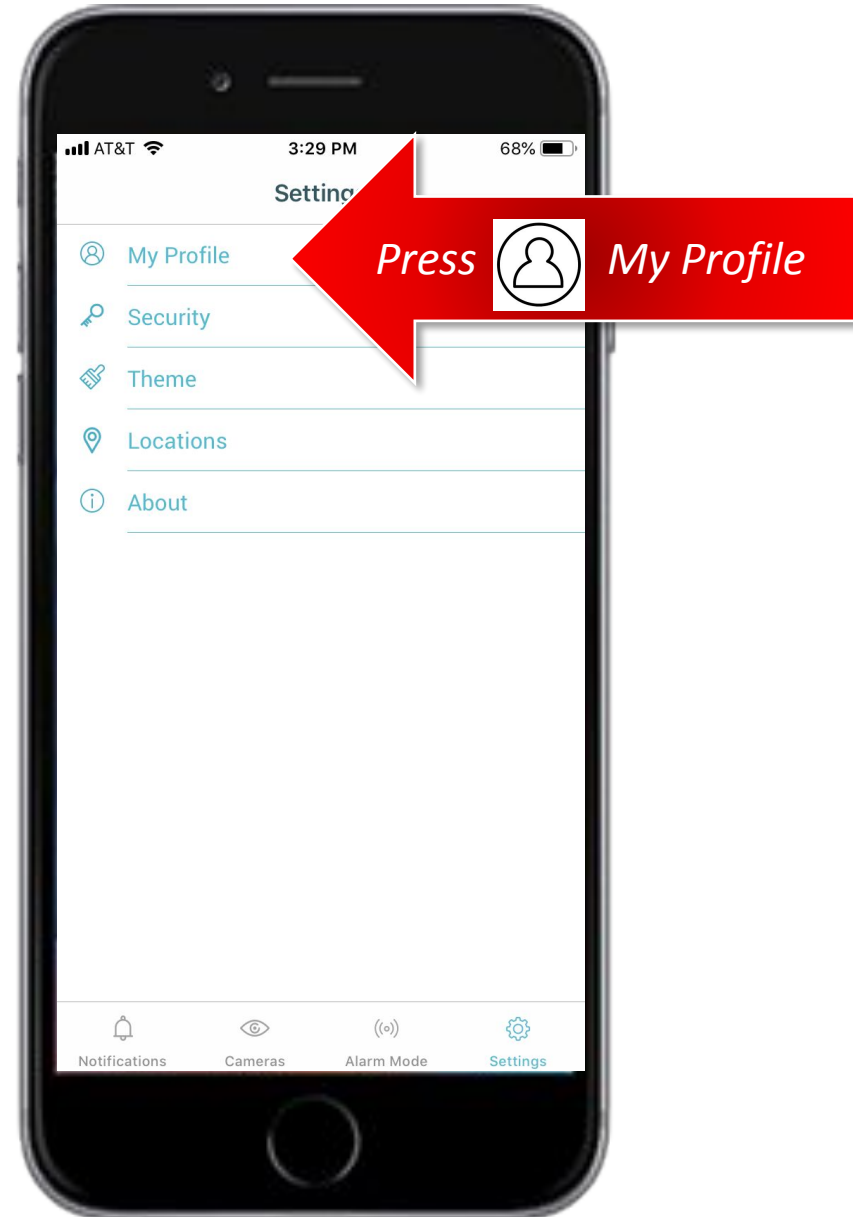

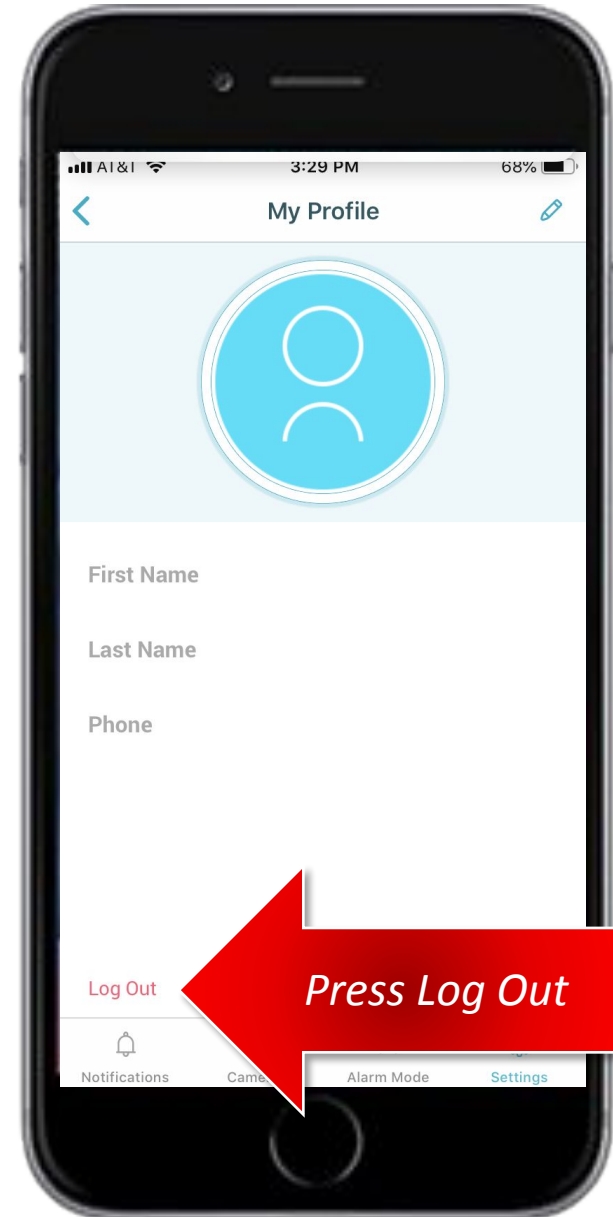
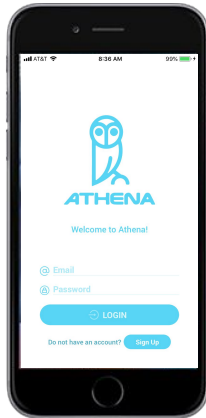
# Logging Out Of the Athena Security Camera System Gun Detection System App

# Filters of Alerts

## Status filter:

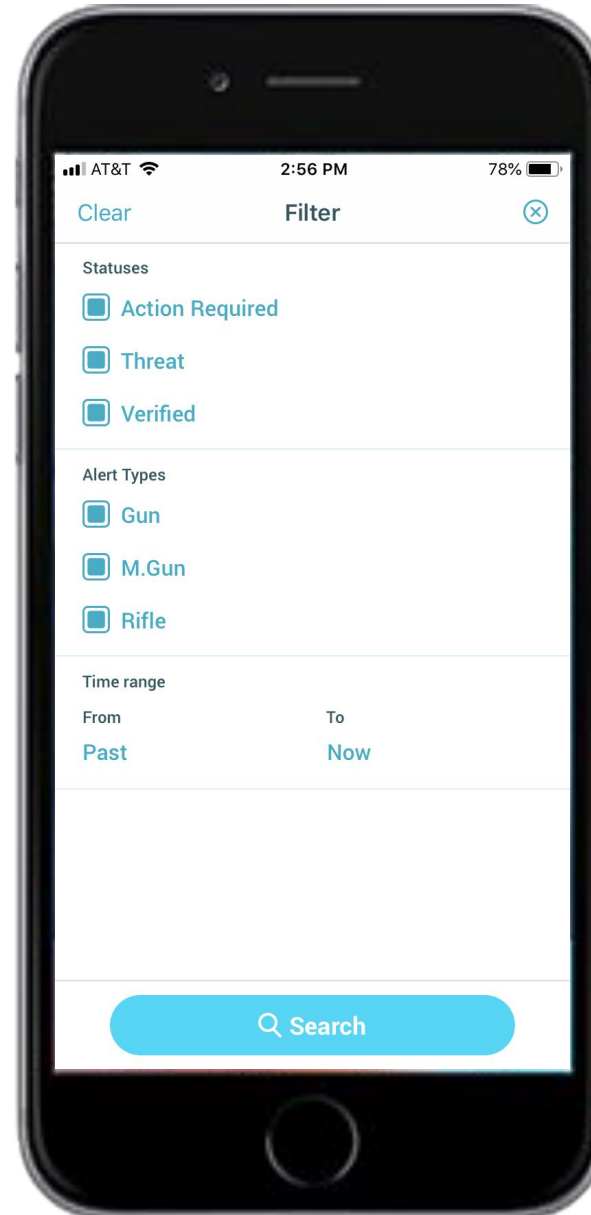
1. Action required stands for “you must select threat or not still”
2. Threat “someone has marked this as a threat already”
3. Verified “someone has marked this as not a threat already.”

## Alert Types:

1. Gun and other types allow you to filter on type of alerts, gun machine gun, slip and falls etc.

## Time Range

1. Allows you to select time frame of events search

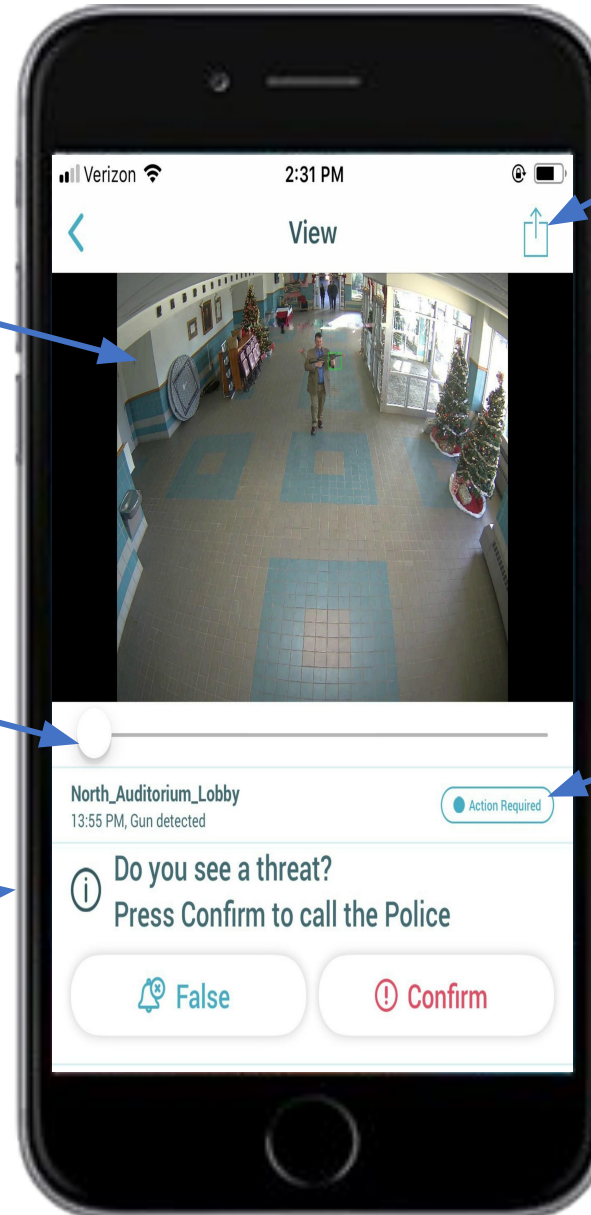

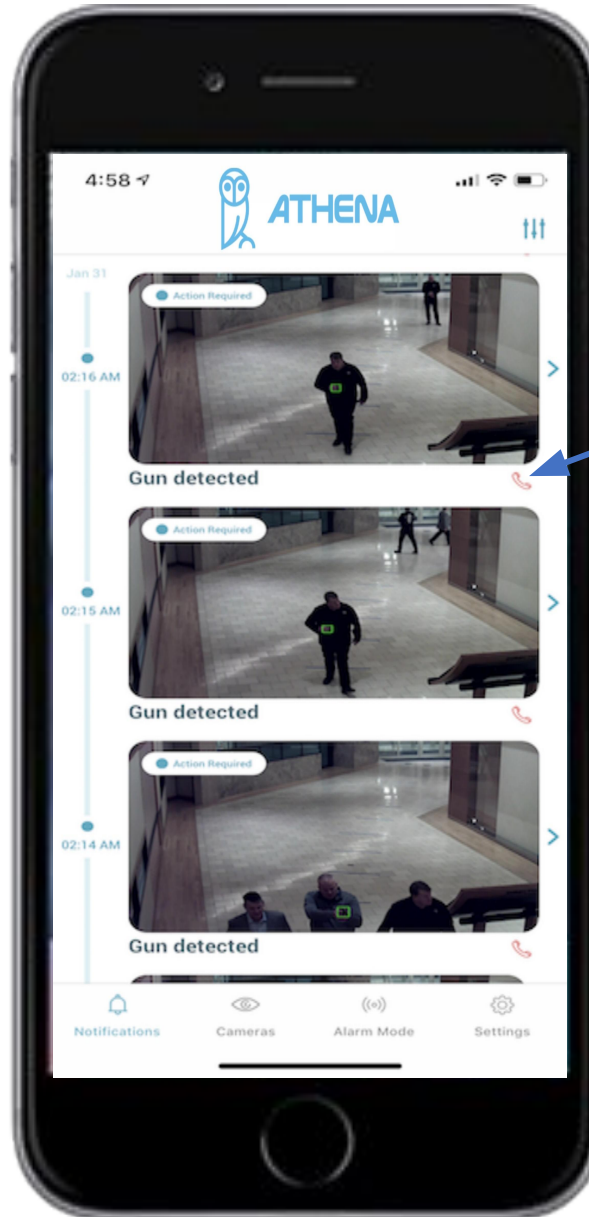

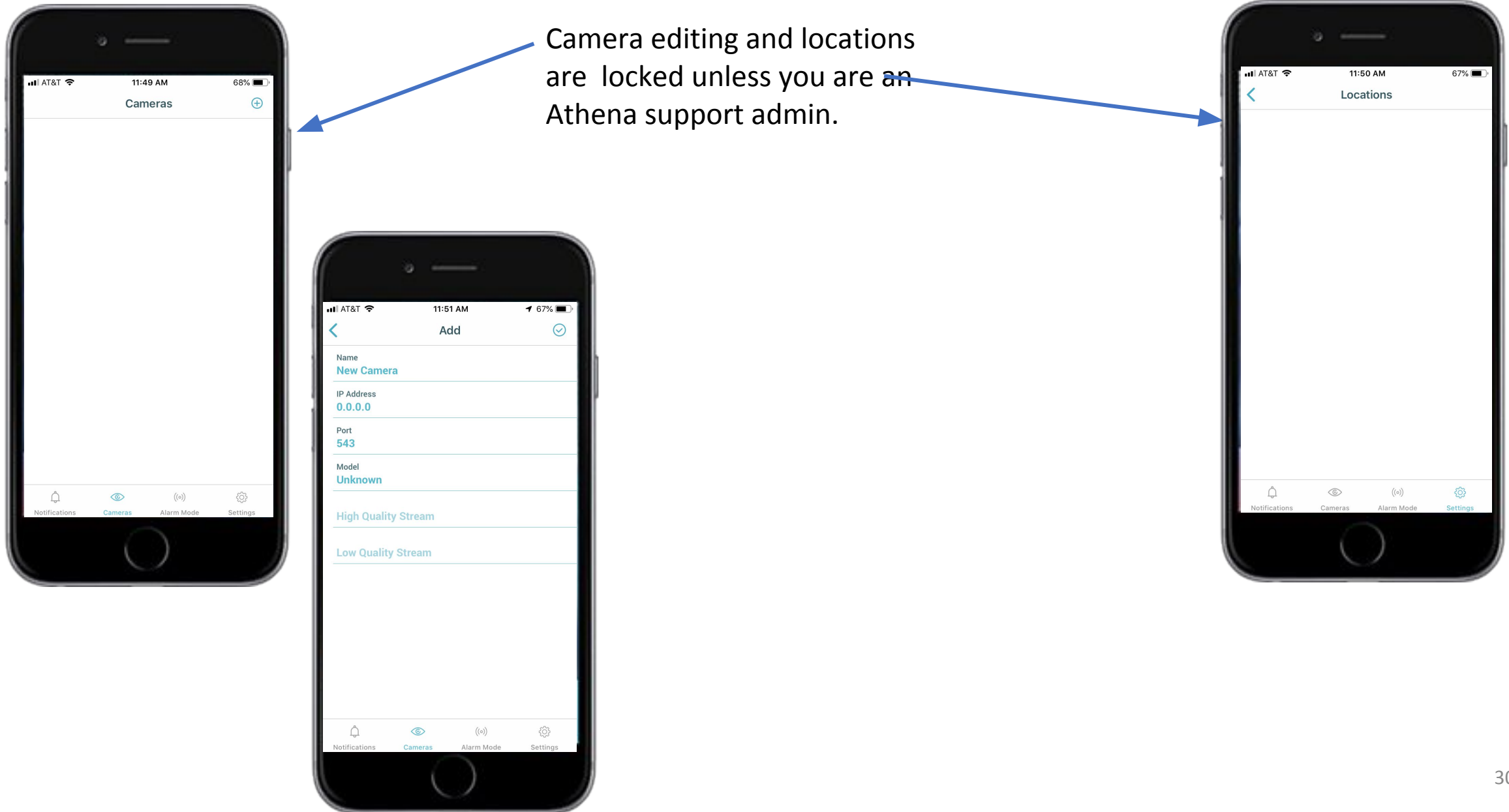
